A mainstream broadsheet newspaper has caught up with the facts, on which we have been reporting and campaigning since 2003.

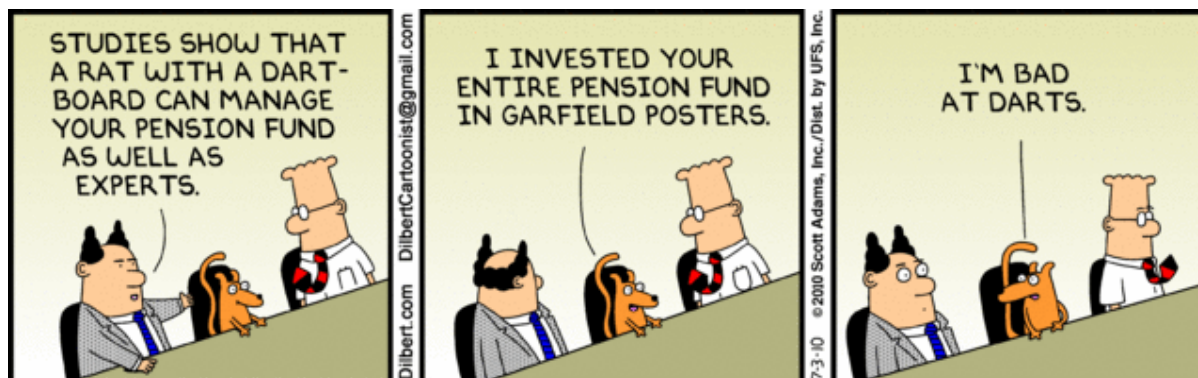
